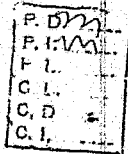

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, W. E. McMillan  
and Minnie McMillan his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One Hundred forty-five <sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> DOLLARS,  
to wit: in full paid by J. H. Ungles, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. H. Ungles  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot number two (2) in Block numbered eight (8) in the Town of Turley Indian Territory, as the same  
appears from the plat of said town.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. H. Ungles  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. H. Ungles that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Minnie McMillan wife of the said W. E. McMillan for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
J. H. Ungles all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
