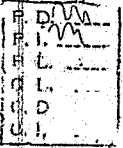

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Charles N. Wickizer
and Margaret C. Wickizer his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of nine hundred fifty DOLLARS,
By C. A. Mayo Fur Co.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C. A. Mayo Fur Co.
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the _____ Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of Lots (2) Two & (3) Three in Block (1) One River View Ad-
dition to Tulsa, I. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said C. A. Mayo Fur Co.
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said C. A. Mayo Fur Co. that they will forever
warrant and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Margaret C. Wickizer wife of the said Charles N. Wickizer for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
C. A. Mayo Fur Co. all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
