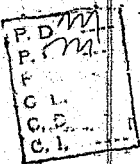

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. B. Macy
and Clemie C. Macy his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Five hundred DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. C. Henis
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Okwasa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of lot six (6) in Block six (6) in the incorporated town of Okwasa
according to the U.S. Government survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. C. Henis
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. C. Henis that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Clemie C. Macy wife of the said J. B. Macy for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
J. C. Henis all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
