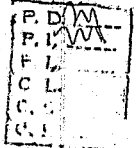

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

The NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the West half (shown on the U.S. Survey as lots 1 and 2) of the
NW 1/4 of Sec 31, T. 19 N. and Range 14 E, Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian
Territory, to-wit: Lot 10, no. Ten Block 3 No Three in Valley Indian Territory,
together with all improvements thereon and the appurtenances thereto belonging, and
warrant the title to the same.

and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, free clear and discharged of and from all former grants, charges, taxes,
judgments, mortgages and other liens and encumbrances, of what soever nature,
