do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C. P. Alexander  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North half of Lot Six (6), Block One Hundred and Sixty Five (165) according to  
the original plat of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said C. P. Alexander  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
And hereby covenant with said C. P. Alexander that we will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
