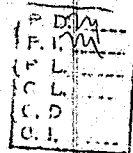

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Nora Burgess  
 and his wife, for and in consideration  
 of the sum of One Thousand DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by George W. Adams, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George W. Adams  
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western  
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Half of the North West quarter and the North Half of the South West quarter of  
Section 24, Township 17, North Range 11, East, being the allotment of India Burgess,  
deceased, to which allotment said Nora Burgess is the sole and only heir at law.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said George W. Adams  
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said George W. Adams that I will forever  
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and  
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
