Know all Men by these Presents, That we, William R. Campbell  
and Emma Campbell his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Fifteen hundred DOLLARS,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by David Etchen.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said David Etchen  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot six (6) in Block twenty nine (29) original Townsite of Collinsville  
according to the United States survey and plat thereof together with all improvements  
of whatsoever nature

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said David Etchen  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said David Etchen that we will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. f

And I, Emma Campbell wife of the said William R. Campbell for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
David Etchen all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
