of the sum of Eight Hundred + Seventy Five <sup>27/100</sup> DOLLARS,  
The receipt of the same being acknowledged and to us in hand paid by Ida E. Cameron

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ida E. Cameron  
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Twenty Five Feet of Lot one (1) Block Eighty Six (86) described as follows. Beginning at a point  
Twenty Five feet southwesterly of the northeasterly corner of Lot One Block Eighty Six, Thence running South Easterly  
One Hundred feet; Thence South Westerly, Twenty Five feet; Thence North Westerly, One Hundred feet; Thence  
northeasterly, Twenty Five feet, to the place of beginning and according to the "Official Plat" and  
"Government Survey" of the City of Tulsa, I. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Ida E. Cameron  
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ida E. Cameron that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
