## WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Esther Richards (nee McIntosh), sister of Simon M<sup>c</sup>Intosh, and deceased, of Jeff S. I. Creek Nation, Indian Territory, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other good & valuable consideration, DOLLARS, to me paid by Rentie M<sup>c</sup>Intosh, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Rentie M<sup>c</sup>Intosh, and unto, heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: All of my right title and interest in and to The North West Quarter, of the Southw<sup>est</sup> Quarter of Section Fourteen (14) Township Nineteen (19) North Range Fourteen (4) East, Being the homestead of Simon M<sup>c</sup>Intosh, deceased, whose Creek File Number is F 4938.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Rentie M<sup>c</sup>Intosh and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging. And hereby covenants with the said Rentie M<sup>c</sup>Intosh that said land are free from incumbrances, that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said Esther Richards (nee McIntosh), do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Rentie M<sup>c</sup>Intosh all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
