Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. W. Hocker and Carrie G. Hocker, his wife, and J. M. Hall  
and Jennie S. Hall, his wife, and J. M. Gillette and Minnie M. Gillette his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Eleven Hundred Twenty-five DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid by Lafayette Galbraith, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Lafayette Galbraith  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Lots Eight (8), Nine (9), Eleven (11), Twelve (12) and  
thirteen (13) in Block Nine (9), also Lots Eleven (11) and Twelve (12) in Block Twelve (12) in  
the Gillette and Hall Addition to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the recorded  
Plat and survey thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Lafayette Galbraith  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Lafayette Galbraith that we will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. Except one oil and gas Lease to Grant C. Stephens  
on his assigns, and J. Carrie G. Hocker wife of the said J. W. Hocker, and J. Jennie S. Hall, wife of the said J. M. Hall.

And I, Minnie M. Gillette wife of the said J. M. Gillette for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
Lafayette Galbraith all our rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
