

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. E. Peirsol
and Ellen L. Peirsol his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Eight hundred & fifty DOLLARS,
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. O. Johnston and S. E. Thibeault
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Oreek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The south half of lot two (2) in Block (184) one hundred and eighty four in the city of
Julsa, Ind. Ter. according to the official plat thereof together with all the improvements thereon

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said E. O. Johnston and S. E. Thibeault
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. O. Johnston and S. E. Thibeault that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ellen L. Peirsol wife of the said J. E. Peirsol for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. O. Johnston
and S. E. Thibeault all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
