WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Miley M'Intosh (nee Richards), wife of Simon M'Intosh,
and deceased of Creek Nation, Indian Territory, his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable consideration, DOLLARS,
to me paid by Lewis M'Intosh, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Lewis M'Intosh,
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation, Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: All of my right, title and interest in and to the Northwest Quarter of the
South West Quarter of section Fourteen (14) Township Nineteen (19) North Range Fourteen (14) East, the Homestead
of said Simon M'Intosh deceased.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Lewis M'Intosh,
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenants with said Lewis M'Intosh that said lands are free from encumbrances, that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said Miley M'Intosh, for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lewis M'Intosh
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
