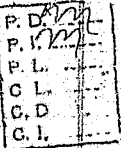

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Lon R. Stansbery and John N. Day
and Myrtle C. Stansbery and Katherine M. Day, their wives his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Seven Hundred (\$700.00) DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Frank A. Rich
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nations Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots 1 and 2, Block 4, in Stansbery Addition to Tulsa, I. T. according
to recorded plat of same

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Frank A. Rich
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant s with said Frank A. Rich that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Myrtle C. Stansbery and Katherine M. Day ^{wives} of the said Lon R. Stansbery and John N. Day for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Frank A. Rich all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
