WARRANTY DEED WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

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Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Rentie McIntosh and Lewis McIntosh
and Glorine McIntosh, wife of Rentie McIntosh of Muscogee, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Four Hundred (400⁰⁰) DOLLARS,
to us paid by J. Garfield Buell receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. Garfield Buell
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North West Quarter of the South West Quarter of Section Fourteen (14) Township Nineteen (19) North
Range Fourteen (14) East. The Homestead of Simon McIntosh deceased a Creek Freedman whose Roll
number is F4938.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. Garfield Buell
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenants with said J. Garfield Buell that said lands are free from incumbrances that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Glorine McIntosh, wife of the said Rentie McIntosh, for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. Garfield Buell
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
