do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said George Clarence Stahlschmidt, Senior
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Twenty Eighth Recording Dist. Western
(28) District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:
Lots Sixteen (16) and Seventeen (17) in Block Three (3) Forest Park Addition
to the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said George Clarence Stahlschmidt, Sr.
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said George Clarence Stahlschmidt Senior that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
