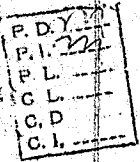

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Low R. Stansbury
and Myrtle L. Stansbury his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Five Hundred and Forty no. 100 DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us in hand paid by J. W. Weaver,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. W. Weaver
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Numbered Nine (9), Block Two (2), in the Stansbury Addition to the City of Tulsa, Ind. Ter.
and according to the record plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. W. Weaver
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. W. Weaver that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Myrtle L. Stansbury wife of the said Low R. Stansbury for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
J. W. Weaver all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
