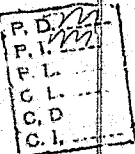

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, I Frank C. Giddings (unmarried)  
 and his wife, for and in consideration  
 of the sum of Six hundred (\$600.00) DOLLARS,  
The payment of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Thomas A. Butler and Vashli Butler  
 and unto their heirs and assigns; forever, the following lands lying in the Western  
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lots Three (3) Four (4) Five (5) & Six (6) and the South Sixty one feet  
(S. 61ft) of Lots One (1) and Two (2) all in Block One (1) of "Highlands" Addition to  
Julen, I.T. according to the Plat thereof as filed in the office of the Recorder of the 28th Recording  
district, I.T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Thomas A. Butler and Vashli Butler  
 and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Thomas A. Butler and Vashli Butler that I will forever  
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
