Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Curtis W. Bucy
and Daisy Bucy his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Fifty DOLLARS,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. D. Deeds
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Broken Arrow Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot nineteen (12) Block Thru (13) Homestead Addition to Broken
Arrow, Creek Nation, Indian Territory.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said E. D. Deeds
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said E. D. Deeds that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Daisy Bucy wife of the said Curtis W. Bucy for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
E. D. Deeds all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
