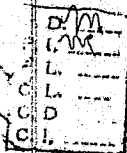

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, I, Daniel Company, a single man  
and wife of Brynston, J. J., Muskogee (Creek) Nation, Indian Territory his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One dollar and other good and valuable considerations to me paid by DOLLARS,  
International Land Company, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said International Land Company, its successors,  
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, the following <sup>described lot or parcel of ground</sup> lands lying <sup>in being title</sup> in the g. creek nation, Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North Half of the South West Quarter and the South East Quarter of the North West  
Quarter of Section Thirty Two (32), Township Nineteen (19) North Range Twelve (12) East, of the  
Indian base and meridian of the Indian Territory according to the government survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said International Land Company, its successors,  
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.  
And, hereby covenants <sup>with the said International Land Company that said lands are free from all</sup> <sup>incumbrances</sup> that I will forever  
warrant and defend the title <sup>to</sup> of said lands against all <sup>lawful</sup> claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
