International Land Company, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said International Land Company, its successors
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The East half of the South East quarter and the South West Quarter of the South east
quarter of Section Thirty, (30) Township, (19) nineteen north Range Twelve East, (12)

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said International Land Company, its successors
and unto heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And, hereby covenants with the said International Land Company, its successors that I will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all lawful claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
