WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, William H. Large
and Alta Large ^{of Broken Arrow, Creek Nation, Indian Territory} his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Four Hundred and Seventy five (\$475.00) DOLLARS,
to us paid by John Henry receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John Henry
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following ^{described lots, piece of ground and being situated} lands lying ^{in the town of Broken Arrow, Creek Nation} in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots One (1) and Two (2) in Block Thirteen (13) in said town of Broken Arrow

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said John Henry
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And ^{we} hereby covenants with ^{the} said John Henry that said lands are free from all incumbrances that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all ^{possible} claims whatever.

And I, Alta Large wife of the said William H. Large for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
John Henry all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
