Archibald, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said R. B. Archibald and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following ^{described lot a fence ground} lands lying in the ^{on being actual} Western District of Creek Nation, to-wit:

Lot number fifteen in Block number forty seven in the town of Broken Arrow, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said R. B. Archibald and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said R. B. Archibald that said lands are free from incumbrances ^{lawful} that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And J. Jessie Sprague wife of said Wm Sprague for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. B. Archibald all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
