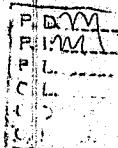

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, I, John Norfer
 and his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of One & no/100 DOLLARS,
 And other good and valuable considerations, in hand paid by J.B. Wright, the receipt of
 which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J.B. Wright
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The East Half of North West Quarter and the North-west Quarter of the North West
Quarter of Section Ten (10), Township Nineteen N. Range Fourteen (14) East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. B. Wright
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
 And hereby covenant with said J.B. Wright that I will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
