Know all Men by these Presents, That we, A. B. Campbell  
and M. M. Campbell his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of Two Hundred Ten and No/100, DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by W. G. Brockman, the receipt  
whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. G. Brockman  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: the North 1/2 and 1/2 part of lot-  
numbered three in Block numbered six in the  
Trinity and Gillette addition to Tulsa, Ch. T. according  
to the recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said W. G. Brockman  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. G. Brockman that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, M. M. Campbell wife of the said A. B. Campbell for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. G. Brockman  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
