WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Rebecca Hissong
and William O. Hissong, her husband, his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Eleven Hundred DOLLARS,
Cash in hand paid by Rebecca J. Edgar, the purchaser

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Rebecca J. Edgar
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Eleven (11) in Block Twelve (12) in the Hodge Addition to Tulsa, Indian Territory

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Rebecca J. Edgar
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Rebecca J. Edgar that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Rebecca Hissong wife of the said William O. Hissong for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Rebecca J. Edgar all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
