Know all Men by these Presents, That we, W. J. Gregg

of the sum of Three Thousand Seven Hundred DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Wm. W. Shackle
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the city of Tulsa in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Twenty-five (S. 25) feet of lot number two (2)
and the North Twenty-five (N. 25) feet of lot number
three (3) in block number One Hundred and Seventy-five
(175) in the original town of Tulsa as shown by the
recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Wm. W. Shackle
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Wm. W. Shackle that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Leanne B. Gregg wife of the said W. J. Gregg for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Wm. W. Shackle
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
