Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. M. Gillette
and Minnie M. Gillette his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of three thousand (\$3000.00) DOLLARS,
and other valuable considerations, to us on hand
paid, by J. D. Hagler receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. D. Hagler
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all our undivided two-thirds interest in and to
the North west quarter of the North west quarter of
the North west quarter of Section Twelve (12), Township
Nineteen (19) North, Range Twelve (12) East, and con-
taining Ten (10) acres more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. D. Hagler
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S. with said J. D. Hagler that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Minnie M. Gillette wife of the said J. M. Gillette for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. D. Hagler
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
