Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. J. Harbour
and F. J. Harbour his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty DOLLARS,
paid to them by A. S. Harbour the receipt of which
is hereby accepted and acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said A. S. Harbour
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Arub Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot one (1) in Block One (1) in Harbour's Addition to
the City of Tulsa C. T. according to the certified
and dedicated plat thereof now on file in the office
of the Deputy clerk of the U. S. District Court
in Tulsa C. T.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said A. S. Harbour
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S. with said A. S. Harbour that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, F. J. Harbour wife of the said J. J. Harbour for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. S. Harbour
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
