WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Mary L. Hogan a single
~~and~~ woman ~~his wife~~, for and in consideration
 of the sum of One Thousand Eighty (1800) DOLLARS,
 to her in hand paid by W. C. Buck; the receipt
 whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. C. Buck
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the County of Tulsa Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The northerly half of lot numbered two in Block
 numbered One Hundred Ninety-five, allowing for the
 deviation of the Townsite from the true meridian ad-
 line being parallel with the respective lot and block
 lines, said lot fronting fifty feet on Boston Avenue
 and having a depth of One Hundred Forty feet

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said W. C. Buck
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. C. Buck that she will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, the wife of the said W. C. Buck for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
