WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

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Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Leighton George
and Mary D. George his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One + 00/100 DOLLARS,
to him paid by the Union Trust Company
of Tulsa Okla. Ter.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Union Trust Company
and unto its heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

An undivided one-third (1/3) interest in Lot No.
Ten (10) in Section eleven (11) Township nineteen
(9) Range Twelve (12) East

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Union Trust Company
and unto its heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Union Trust Company that it will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary D. George wife of the said Leighton George for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Union
Trust Company all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
