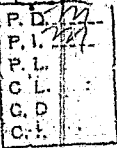

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Chas. Lydell C. Chesley  
and a widow his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of seven hundred sixty 7/8 DOLLARS,  
when hand paid by C. A. Chesley the receipt  
of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C. A. Chesley  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the County of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of lot six (6) in block one (1) in the first-  
landry addition according to the survey and  
plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said C. A. Chesley  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. A. Chesley that he will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Chas. Lydell C. Chesley wife of the said C. A. Chesley for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
C. A. Chesley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
