and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Lea L. Denton that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. except taxes for
1907 and thereafter

And I, Mellie Bline wife of the said J. M. Bline for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lea L. Denton
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
