WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

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Know all Men by these Presents, That we, David Hopkins
and Mary E. Hopkins his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Twelve Hundred Fifty and no/100 DOLLARS,
Receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Julia M. Reinhard
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Clark Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The West-fifty 50 feet of lot four (4) in
Block One Hundred Eighty Six (186) in the City
of Tulsa, Indian Territory, according to the
Official survey and recorded plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Julia M. Reinhard
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Julia M. Reinhard that she will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary E. Hopkins wife of the said David H. Hopkins for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
Julia M. Reinhard all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
