Know all Men by these Presents, That we, John M. Day  
and Katherine M. Day his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of (1500.00) fifteen hundred DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ken R. Stansbury  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

lots one and two Block 2 in the Stansbury  
addition to the City of Tulsa, Ok. according to  
the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Ken R. Stansbury  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ken R. Stansbury that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Katherine M. Day wife of the said John M. Day for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ken R.  
Stansbury all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
