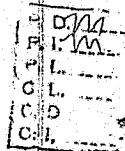

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Minnie Warrentburg
and George Warrentburg her husband ~~his wife~~, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Hundred Eighty five DOLLARS,
in hand paid by E. L. Roop, the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. L. Roop
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The West 25 feet of Lot 21 in Block 21 of the
Auklawn addition to the Town of Tulsa

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said E. L. Roop
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. L. Roop that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, George Warrentburg ^{husband} wife of the said Minnie Warrentburg for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. L. Roop
^{entire} all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
