

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That ~~the~~ Frank B. Giddings

To me in hand paid by Lucie M. Shields

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John W. Shields
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Beek Nation Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot one (14) Block Six (6) in the Highland
addition to the official plat thereof filed in the
28th recording District;

All gas and oil privileges reserved in the above
Frank B. Giddings

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said John W. Shields
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John W. Shields that he will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____ wife of the said _____ for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
