Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Henry R. Gline  
and Etta Fair Gline his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of nine thousand (\$9000.00) DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by John C. Mitchell, receipt  
of which is herewith acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said John C. Mitchell  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

all of lots One (1) Two (2) Three (3) in Block One  
hundred and ninety one (191) and according to  
the official plat of the original townsite of said  
city

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said John C. Mitchell  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John C. Mitchell that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. except taxes  
that may accrue from contract with for paving

And I, Etta Fair Gline wife of the said Henry R. Gline for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John C.  
Mitchell all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
