WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, J. B. Wright and Rosa Wright, his wife, and Charles Ryther and Cynthia A. Ryther his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and ~~Two~~ DOLLARS, to wit in hand paid by Charles C. Wardell and Thomas Y. Wardell, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Charles C. Wardell and Thomas Y. Wardell and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa, Western

District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: That part of Block 11, lot 20, bounded as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the west line of block 11, two hundred and forty-eight feet (408 ft.) from the point of intersection of the north line of block 11 with the west line of the 4th Avenue, avenue, a distance of fifty feet (50 ft.) to a point on the north line of the 12th Street, a distance of one hundred and forty-four feet (144 ft.) to a point, the east line of 12th Street, a distance of forty feet (40 ft.) to the east line of 15th Street, cut to a point whence in a westerly direction along a line parallel with the north line of 15th Street, a distance of one hundred and forty-four feet (144 ft.) to a point, the east line of 15th Street, cut to a point whence in a westerly direction along a line parallel with the north line of 15th Street, being a plot of ground with fifty feet frontage on 15th Street and 144 feet deep.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Charles C. Wardell and Thomas Y. Wardell and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Charles C. Wardell and Thomas Y. Wardell that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And we, Rosa Wright and Cynthia A. Ryther, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Charles C. Wardell and Thomas Y. Wardell all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
