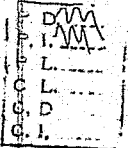

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, George West-
and Lizzie West- his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Eight Hundred 00/100 (800 00) DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
and to us in hand paid by W. E. Halsell of
Vinita, Okla. Ter

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W. E. Halsell
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Northern judicial Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The Northwest quarter of North East Quarter of
Section 874 Twenty Seven and S. E. 1/4 of Sec. 4 of SE
1/4 of Sec. (22) Twenty Two, Township # 219 Range # 132

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said W. E. Halsell
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. E. Halsell that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lizzie West- wife of the said George West- for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. E. Halsell
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
