WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Ella Rose Goff
and E. P. Goff her husband his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of One 100 DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
and to us in hand paid by Dan Hunt—

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Dan Hunt
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: the North one half (1/2) of Lot Six
(6) more particularly described as all that part of said Lot Six (6)
having a frontage of fifty ft. 50' on Detroit Avenue, and a uniform
width of fifty feet (50) a length of one hundred + forty (140) feet to an alley,
and adjoining east fifth (5th) Street in block One Hundred forty
five (145) in said city of Tulsa according to the government
survey thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Dan Hunt—
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Dan Hunt— that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. This deed is given only for the
purpose of correcting a former deed, from which the date was omitted

And I, E. P. Goff wife of the said Ella Rose Goff for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Dan Hunt
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
