Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Luella Thacker
and H. A. Thacker, wife and husband ~~his wife~~, for and in consideration
of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable DOLLARS,
considerations to them in hand paid by Frank
Lehesley, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed
and acknowledged,
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Frank Lehesley
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of West Tulsa Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot number Eleven in Block Numbered
Nine in the Town of West Tulsa, Indian
Territory, according to the recorded plat thereof,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Frank Lehesley
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Frank Lehesley that they will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, H. A. Thacker husband of the said Luella Thacker for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank Lehesley
Lehesley ^{curtesy} all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
