Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Paul C. Jones,
and Emma Jones his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Thirty + 00/100 DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Mrs. M. M. Bradley, the
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Mrs. M. M. Bradley
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the _____ Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North 10 feet of Lot 11 in Block 5, in
Bellview Addition to the Town of Tulsa

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Mrs. M. M. Bradley
and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mrs. M. M. Bradley that we will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emma Jones wife of the said Paul C. Jones for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mrs. M. M.
Bradley all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
