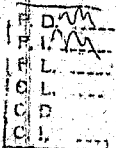

## OFFICIAL FORM

## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Alice M. Rose  
and D. C. Rose, wife and husband his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One Thousand (1000.00) DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by C. C. Sigler, the receipt  
whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged.

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said C. C. Sigler  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The North half of Lot Numbered  
Three in Block Numbered One Hundred Twenty (120)  
in Tulsa d. T., according to the Government Plat thereof,  
allowing for the deviation of the Townsite from the true  
meridian, said tract of ground being rectangular in  
shape and having a frontage of fifty feet on Main Street  
and extending 140 feet to the alley, (this deed being made  
to correct a deed between said parties to same property  
dated May 17th 1903, recorded May 28th 1903, Book  
page 19)

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said C. C. Sigler  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. C. Sigler that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, D. C. Rose husband wife of the said Alice M. Rose for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. C. Sigler  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
