WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Louise Berry, a single woman
and J. H. Berry her attorney in fact his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Five Hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid by H. H. Rasche the receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said H. H. Rasche
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Thirty Two (32) in Block Thirteen (14) in Range
addition to the Town of Tulsa

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said H. H. Rasche
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said H. H. Rasche that she will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Louise Berry wife of the said H. H. Berry for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
H. H. Rasche all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
