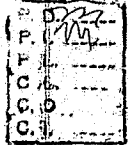

OFFICIAL FORM

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Robert E. Lynch
and G. L. Lynch his wife, for and in consideration
of the sum of Seven Hundred & Fifty no. 00 DOLLARS,
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us in hand paid by,
Percy Wyle and J. A. Lawrence

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Percy Wyle & J. A. Lawrence
and unto Their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: One undivided Two-thirds interest in and to

Lots Five and Six (5 & 6), and the West Five acres of the South East Ten acres of Lot Seven
and Southwest Ten 95.00 (10 95.00) acres of Lot Seven, Section Seven (7) Township
Nineteen (19) N. Range Twelve (12) and being 51 95.00 acres

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Percy Wyle & J. A. Lawrence
and unto His heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Percy Wyle & J. A. Lawrence that They will forever
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever. Except a mortgage for \$500.00 to
Oscar K. Eysenboch due 1/22/08 which was part of the purchase price.

And I, G. L. Lynch wife of the said Robert E. Lynch for and
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Percy Wyle
J. A. Lawrence all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
