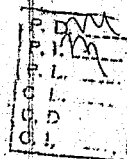

WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Ch. B. Berlin
 and single woman his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of three thousand DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Ch. B. Berlin. The receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Ch. B. Berlin
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot three (3) in Block one hundred and Twenty
24 (26) in Town of Tulsa Indian Territory according
to Government survey and plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Ch. B. Berlin
 and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenants with said Ch. B. Berlin that she will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ellie Swengel wife of the said Ch. B. Berlin for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ch. B. Berlin
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
