WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, John T. Reynolds
 and Alice M. Reynolds his wife, for and in consideration
 of the sum of sixteen hundred DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Phoebe B. Truesler. The receipt
of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Phoebe B. Truesler
 and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation Western
 District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North half of the North West quarter 1/4 of
Section Two (2) in Township seventeen (17) north of
Range Thirteen East of C.M.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said Phoebe B. Truesler
 and unto her heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Phoebe B. Truesler that they will forever
 warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Reynolds wife of the said John T. Reynolds for and
 in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Phoebe
B. Truesler all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
