## WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Bestie H. Crawford  
and Jessie P. Crawford, wife and husband his wife, for and in consideration  
of the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) DOLLARS,  
to us in hand paid by J. B. Wright and Charles Rutherford  
Payee, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. B. Wright and Charles Rutherford  
their undivided one half interest in and to  
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: A tract or portion of Block 10, hundred and one (101) in  
the city of Tulsa as it appears in the official map thereof, and beginning  
at the north end of the south line of Boston Avenue at about  
extinguished by the north line of Rockwell (2nd) Street, and running  
thence in a northwesterly direction along the east side of Boston Avenue for  
a distance of one hundred fifty (150) feet thence eastward a distance of one  
hundred forty (140) feet to and including thence along the  
west side of said avenue fifty (50) feet, thence westward along the  
Rockwell (2nd) Street, thence westward along the  
Rockwell (2nd) Street for a distance of one hundred  
forty (140) feet to the point from whence it began  
having been described by metes and bounds as follows:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. B. Wright and Charles Rutherford  
and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. B. Wright and Charles Rutherford that they will forever
