WARRANTY DEED—WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we, Marie V. Meyer and Paul C. Meyer and wife and husband of the said, Western District, his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) to us in hand paid by J. B. Wright and Charles Ryther, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said J. B. Wright and Charles Ryther, and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: That portion of block two hundred and one (201) in the City of Tulsa, as it appears in the official plat hereof, and beginning for the所述 land bounded on the east line of Boston Avenue at a point intersected by the North line of Thirtieth (30th) Street and running thence in a Northward direction along the East side of Boston Avenue for a distance of one hundred feet (100') and thence East forty-five (45°) degrees parallel with Thirtieth (30th) Street for a distance of three hundred forty (340') feet to an alley, thence to the North line of Thirtieth (30th) Street and thence parallel along said Thirtieth (30th) Street for a distance of one hundred forty (140') feet to the front of beginning; the alley in said block having been changed by Ordinance # 159 of the City Council.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said J. B. Wright and Charles Ryther and unto their heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. B. Wright and Charles Ryther that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
