whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged

do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said E. C. Smiley  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western  
District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

lots numbered One, Two, and Three in Block  
numbered Two of the Bliss Addition to Tulsa  
according to the recorded plat thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said E. C. Smiley  
and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. C. Smiley that they will forever  
warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Margaret Hagler wife of the said J. D. Hagler for and  
in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. C. Smiley  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
